

RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Human Services Committee to approve Distribution Plans for the minor "P" accounts for the annual BPA payments for the following reasons: 1. The half shares of the annual payment to the custodial parent, 2. High School Senior expenses, 3. Minors who are not 18 years old, but who graduated or received their GED. The BIA will not release the first payment (\$5,989.17) and all the interest earned until the individual has reached 18 years of age or is scheduled to graduate from high school, whichever is later in accordance with public law 103-486 passed on 11/2/94. All IIM accounts established by the BIA for minors will be supervised by the BIA. There will be no retroactive ½ share payments released. The ½ share will be released on annual basis only.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Colville Business Council, meeting in SPECIAL SESSION this 11th day of October, 2001 acting for and in behalf of the Colville Confederated Tribes, Nespelem, Washington, do hereby approve the above recommendation of the Human Services-Committee.

The foregoing was duly enacted by the Colville Business Council by a vote of 7 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 ABSTAINED, under authority contained in Article V, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, ratified by the Colville Indians on February 26, 1938, and approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on April 19, 1938.
